
**Book Fair Dates 3/14-3/17!** Students will have a designated time to walk through the book fair with their class.

Photos of the bins were put online and the top ten vote getters won! Thank you so much to all those who shared and liked our entry!



There will be an intramural boys' volleyball club, coached by Mr. O'Rourke, starting in March. Watch this space for more information.




# CDU-Garden News
